

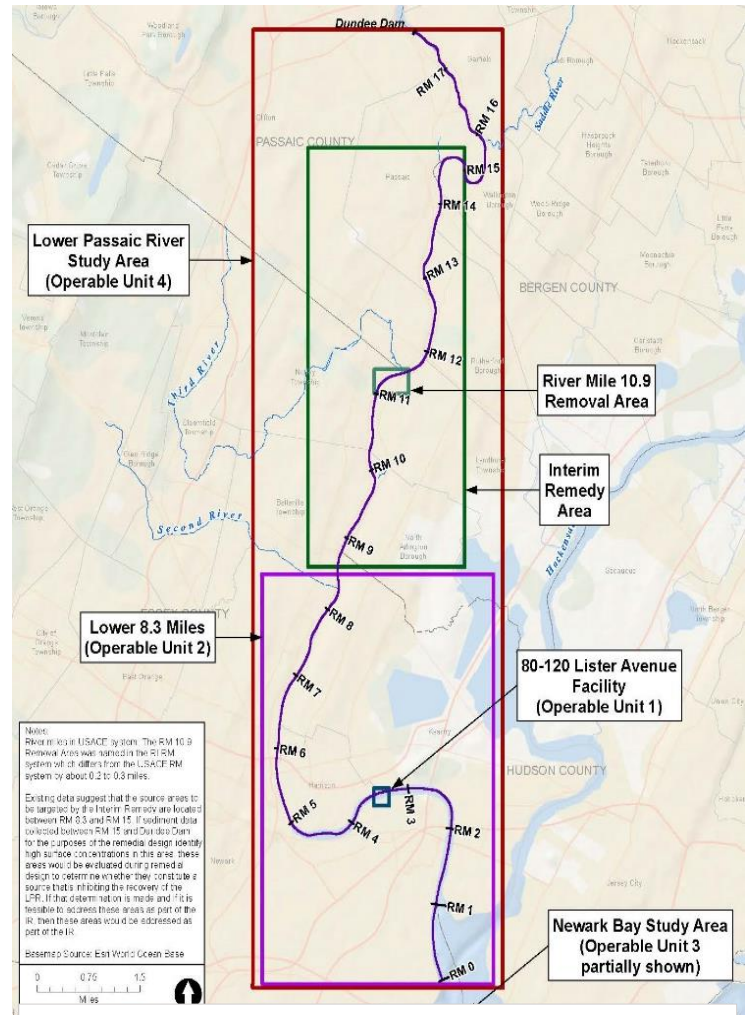


DIAMOND ALKALI SUPERFUND SITE COMMUNITY MEETING
