

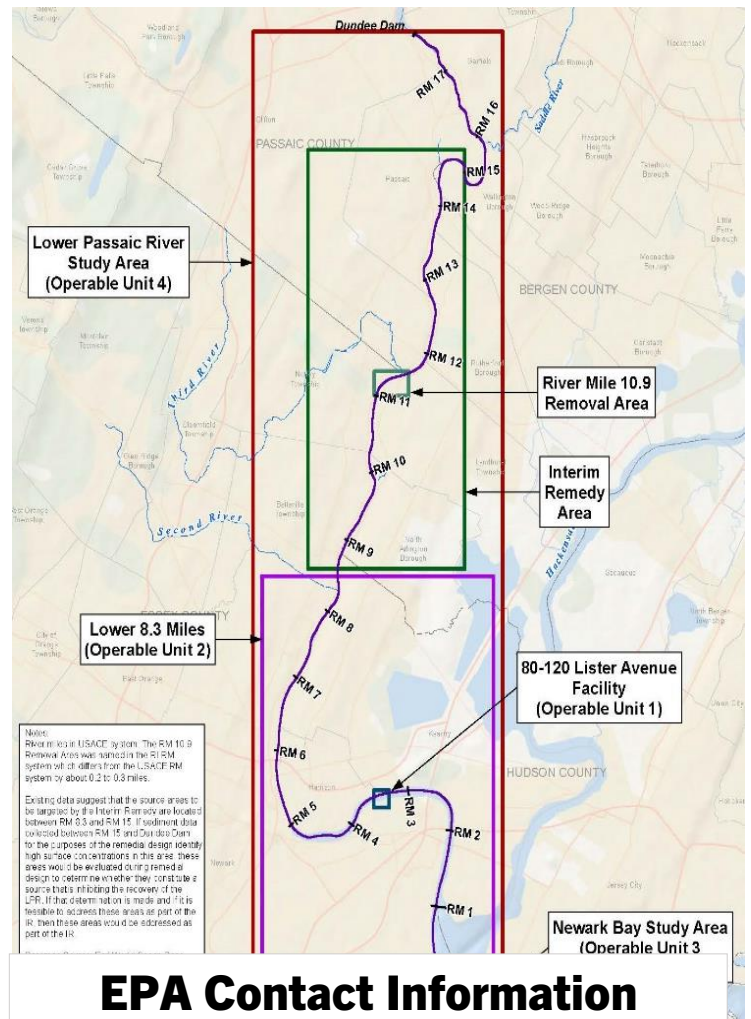


# DIAMOND ALKALI SUPERFUND SITE COMMUNITY MEETING
